PREPARATION FOR LIFE AFTER SCHOOL

Our aim is to ensure that our pupils have a real and practical knowledge of life after Kilgraston and confidence in their future plans. We offer a bespoke Sixth Form Studies programme over two years to help prepare pupils for what lies ahead. We supervise and assist lessons in CV writing and offer one-to-one interview skill sessions with external partners.

Our Sixth Form pupils take four or five Highers in their first year. In their second year each will study a selection of Advanced Highers or perhaps new Higher subjects.

Kilgraston is a member of Unifrog, a careers platform. This gives our pupils the opportunity to explore the many different positive destinations available post school.

Our UCAS programme is tailor made to suit your daughters' needs and comprises of Year Head and tutor interviews. Girls are encouraged to partake in Super Curriculum activities in their area of interest thus enhancing their research, writing and public speaking skills.

Our pupils benefit from the leadership opportunities which are encompassed in our Prefect System and our School Mentoring Programme.

PASTORAL CARE AND BOARDING

In Sixth Form, monitoring pupils' academic and pastoral well-being is at the forefront. We have a team of tutors working with the Deputy Head of Sixth Form and Head of Sixth Form to ensure pupils are supported and progressing well. Academic targets are set regularly as well as reviewing pupils extra-curricular commitments. Pupils are encouraged to celebrate their success in Year Group meetings and achievement assemblies. We train pupils to be part of our Anti-Bullying ambassador programme and Mental Health Awareness Teams.

A programme of Social and Health Education is designed to be tailored to the needs of our pupils in Sixth Form.

In terms of boarding, we offer full-time and flexible boarding options in Sixth Form and would encourage pupils to use this facility as part of their preparation for the transition to leaving home.





SIXTH FORM CALENDAR HIGHLIGHTS

Here at Kilgraston, we are lucky to have a busy calendar of both academic and extracurricular activities.

Both our Higher and Advanced Higher courses feature the opportunity to go beyond the classroom. For example, our A Level Art pupils visit Scotland's main art galleries and museums, whilst our geographers and biologists take part in field trips.

Our pupils can take part in cultural visits to European cities such as Athens and Rome. These last around five days and are cross-curricular in focus.

At the end of Upper Sixth we organise a Leavers' residential trip with our Sixth Formers in charge of the details, even choosing the destination.

Throughout the year, we also have regular social events such as quiz nights and our annual Ball with our brother School, Merchiston Castle, a boys' School in Edinburgh.
